Lent begins this week! I invite your full participation in this holy season. Lent begins this Wednesday, with blessing and distribution of ashes at our many services: 6:30 am (Mass, SH), 12:00 (Service, SJ), 4:15 (Service, SJ), 5:30 (Mass, SP), 7:00 (Youth Mass, SJ), 7:30 (Service, SH). Please consult your copy of eSPIRITu for a full schedule of Lenten services and other activities.

Saturday morning Scripture Reflections: A beautiful way to enter into the spirit of this special season is to study the special scriptures of the Sundays of Lent - carefully chosen to help us reflect, with our fellow Catholic Christians throughout the world, on the invitation and the challenges that this season brings. We invite you *all* to gather with us in St. James Hall each Saturday at 9 am for an hour and a half of deep reflection on these special scriptures that we will hear again at our week-end liturgies.

Biblical Characters of Lent - a six-week series of scripture studies focusing on the characters that appear in our Lenten scriptures, will be held at Sacred Heart Hall beginning next Sunday, Feb. 10, 10:45 am. The sessions will be led by Dennis Nesser. All are invited!
