Dear friends -

The holiest of weeks is upon us! I encourage all of you, my friends in Christ, to join me in giving this week to God! I write this in anticipation of the great liturgies of this Palm Sunday, expressing our faith publicly through procession, and hearing that long but dramatically moving gospel - the Passion of Jesus as found in the Gospel of Mark. Our liturgies end without a recessional song today - as if to say, "we're not done yet!" Go home; take care of necessities; we'll see you back soon!

A great thanks to Father John Makothakat, who will preside at the Holy Week liturgies at St. Patrick's this year!

This week's schedule of activities:

Monday - a quiet day. Read, if you will, today's gospel: John 12:1-11 - the story of Mary, the sister of Martha and Lazarus, who anoints Jesus' feet, and prepares him for burial. This would be a good day to make a private Stations of the Cross at St. James. Booklets are at the church entrance.

Tuesday - Participate in Mass today! Start your day with our 6:30 am liturgy at St. James, or end it with a 6 pm mass in St. Patrick's Hall. If you cannot attend, read today's gospel: John 13:21-38.

Wednesday - Evening mass is at 5:30 pm at St. James, followed by Stations, and a presentation to our youth by Sister Mary Fagan, SHSp at 6:30. Sister Mary teaches at the Healy-Murphy Center in San Antonio, and is widely sought for speaking presentations. All are invited; especially the parents of our youth.

Holy Thursday - Lent ends today, only to give way to an even more sacred time - the Sacred Triduum: the three-day remembrance of Jesus' passion and resurrection. There is NO noon mass today at Sacred Heart. Masses are at 7 pm at St. James, and also at St. Patrick's. After the St. James mass, we will process along St. Lawrence Street to Sacred Heart, where we repose the Blessed Sacrament and remain in quiet prayer through midnight. At St. Patrick's, the hall will be open till 10 pm. We keep watch with Jesus, who asks us as he did the disciples in the garden: "Will you watch one hour with me?" An opening song will begin each hour; a scriptural rosary will be prayed; then silent prayer until the closing song.

We invite parish groups and organizations to keep vigil each hour at Sacred Heart. This year's schedule is as follows:

Till 10 pm: 9:30 Choir; youth; Altar Society; Catholic Daughters
10-11 pm: 8:00 Choir; Guadalupanas; Comunidad; Santo Nombre
11 pm-12 m.: Young Adult Choir; Knights

Good Friday - Catholics eat no meat today, and those who are able should also fast - eating only one full meal. No masses are held anywhere in the world today; hosts consecrated at the Holy Thursday services will be used for Holy Communion at each service. Services are as follows:

12 n.: St. James.
4:00 pm: Independence Park. Stations of the Cross led by families; communion service at Sacred Heart.
7:00 pm: St. Patrick.
7:00 pm: Sacred Heart. Dramatización de la Pasión por los Jóvenes.

Holy Saturday: 8 pm Easter Vigil Service, both at Sacred Heart and St. Patrick. At this most beautiful of all our Church's liturgies, we will welcome a total of eight persons into our faith community, and another eight through a Profession of Faith in the Catholic Church. Come prepared to spend the evening at church; make this a "date with the Risen Lord!"

Easter Sunday: No 5:15 mass today; otherwise, regular mass schedule.

Queridos amigos -

¡Ya nos llegó la semana mas santa! Les animo a todos, mis amigos en Cristo, a entregar al Señor esta semana. Escribo estas palabras anticipando las liturgias grandes del Domingo de Ramos, expresando nuestra fe públicamente por procesión, y escuchando ese evangelio largo pero emocionante - la Pasión de Jesús según San Marcos. Las liturgias terminan sin canto de salida ahora - que quiere decir - "no hemos terminado esta liturgia." Vaya a su casa por un rato, pero regrese muy pronto!

¡Un agradecimiento enorme al Padre John Makothakat, que celebrará las liturgias de Semana Santa en San Patricio este año!

Horario para Esta Semana:

Lunes - un día muy silencioso. Lee el evangelio de hoy - Juan 12:1-11 - la historia de María, la hermana de Marta y Lázaro, que unge los pies de Jesús, preparándolo para su entierro. Un buen día para hacer una viacrucis en privado. Hay libritos disponibles en St. James.

Martes: ¡Participe en la misa hora! Misas son a las 6:30 am en St. James, y 6 pm en San Patricio. Si no puede venir, lee el evangelio de hoy: Juan 13:21-38.

Miércoles: Misa es a las 5:30 pm en St. James, seguida por la Viacrucis, y una presentación a los jóvenes por Hra. Mary Fagan, SHSp at 6:30. Hra. Mary enseña en el Healy-Murphy Center en San Antonio. Todos están invitados, especialmente los padres de nuestra juventud.

Jueves Santo: La cuaresma termina ahora, y empieza un tiempo hasta mas sagrada - el Triduo Sagrado: tres días de recordar la pasión y resurrección de Jesús. NO hay misa de 12:00 en Sagrado Corazón ahora. Misas son 7 pm en St. James, y también en San Patricio. Después de la misa en St. James, iremos en procesión a Sagrado Corazón, donde pondremos el Santísimo y quedaremos en oración hasta la medianoche. En San Patricio, el salón estará abierto hasta las 10 pm. Vigilamos con Jesús, que no pide lo mismo como los discipulos en el huerto: "¿Pueden vigilar una hora conmigo?" Cada hora empezará con un canto; luego un rosario con escrituras; y oración en silencio hasta el canto final.

Invitamos a los grupos y organizaciones de la parroquia a vigilar cada hora en Sagrado Corazón. El horario es lo siguiente:

Hasta las 10: 9:30 Coro, Jóvenes, Sociedad del Altar, Hijas Católicas
10-11 pm: 8:00 Coro, Guadalupanas, Comunidad, Santo Nombre
11-12 pm: Coro de Jóvenes Adultos; Caballeros de Colón

Viernes Santo: Los Católicos no comen carne ahora; y los que pueden, deben ayunar - comiendo no mas una comida plena. No hay misas en ninguna parte del mundo; hostias consagradas en los servicios de Jueves Santo se usarán para la Sagrada Comunión. Servicios son los siguientes:

12 n: St. James.
4 pm: Parque de Independencia. Viacrucis guiada por familias, terminando con servicio de comunión en Sagrado Corazón.
7 pm: San Patricio.
7 pm: Sagrado Corazón. Incluye una dramatización de la Pasión por los jóvenes.

Sábado de Gloria: 8 pm Vigilia de Pascua, en Sagrado Corazón y San Patricio. En esta liturgia mas bella de todo el año, recibiremos un total de 8 personas a la comunidad de fe, y otro 8 por Profesión de Fe en la Iglesia Católica. Venga preparado a pasar toda la tarde en la iglesia - una cita con el Señor resucitado!

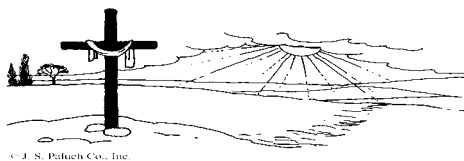
