Ministries' Training: Have you considered serving our Catholic Community as a Lector or Eucharistic Minister? We will have training sessions on May 3 and May 17, 2-5 pm. Ministers should be, first of all, Catholics who have been baptized and confirmed, and who participate in Mass and receive the sacraments regularly. They should have a willingness to serve our community in times both convenient and inconvenient.

Lectors should be people with natural skills for proclaiming God's word in a public setting, who study the scriptures regularly and are willing to spend time in preparation for their ministry. Eucharistic Ministers should be people who, in addition to receiving communion regularly, should have a deep reverence for the Divine Presence in the Eucharist. Please speak directly with Father Paul if you are interested in attending these workshops, or just to get more information.

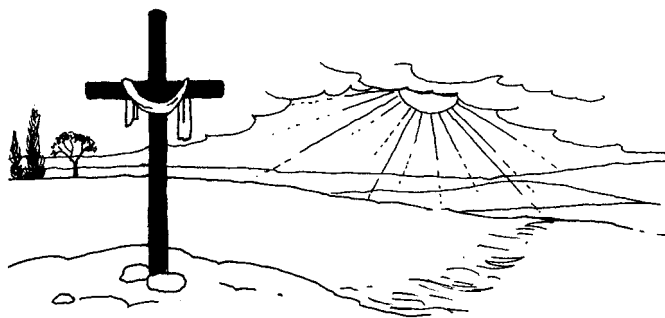
Special Mass of Divine Mercy: will be held at 3 pm next Sunday, April 19 at St. James Church. All are invited to this bilingual celebration.
