St. James Feast Day: This coming Saturday, May 3, is the feast of St. James the Less - our parish patron! James the Less, one of the twelve apostles and a faithful disciple of Jesus, is also considered to be the author of the "Letter of James" found in the Bible. In this letter, he teaches us a great deal about the early Church and its challenges. James was a "realist" - insisting that the faith we profess be lived in our everyday lives, through our respect for one another and our outreach to the poor and needy (cf. James 1:27). Perhaps his most well-known phrase is found in Chapter 2, verse 26 of his letter: "For just as a body without a spirit is dead, so also faith without works is dead". We take to heart the message of our patron, and pray for a generous dose of his spirit and passion!

Our Religious Education Program invites you to the end-of-year mass this Wednesday, 6:30 pm at St. James. We will offer a special blessing for our Confirmation students at that liturgy. Forty-one students will be confirmed this year, at the 5:15 pm mass on Sunday, May 18. The mass will be held at St. James Church, with Bishop John Yanta, retired bishop of Amarillo, officiating.
