**Among the many debated issues on the political front** is that of an immigration policy for our nation that is just and fair. As U.S. Catholics, we are very invested in this issue; most of our own ancestors were immigrants and many members of our community are also first- and second-generation immigrants. The U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops has formulated five principles for Comprehensive Immigration Reform, in keeping with our worldwide Church's social teaching. They are the following:

1. To make family a priority in immigration law
2. To insist the worker programs contain protection for U.S. and migration workers
3. To allow for an earned legalization program for the undocumented in the country
4. To restore due process protections
5. To respond to the economic, political, and social root causes of migration.

While general in nature, these are the guiding principles for good immigration policy as put forth by our bishops. We look forward to continued efforts by the U.S. Congress to enact comprehensive immigration reform which will bring our immigrant brothers and sisters out of the shadows and improve our nation's security. As the political debate continues, they may be useful measuring points for us in judging the appropriateness of policies put forward. **Entre los asuntos políticos en estos días** es la formación de una policía para inmigrantes a nuestra nación que es justo. Como Católicos en este país, estamos muy invertidos en este asunto. La mayoría de nuestros ancestros son inmigrantes, y muchos miembros de nuestra comunidad Católica también son inmigrantes. La Conferencia de Obispos Estadounidenses ha propuesto cinco principios para la Reforma de Policías Sobre la Inmigración, guardando las enseñanzas sociales de la Iglesia. Son los siguientes:

1. La familia debe ser una prioridad en las leyes sobre los inmigrantes.
2. Los programas para los trabajadores deben proteger a los trabajadores de los Ee.Uu. y de los inmigrantes.
3. Hay que ver provisiones para que los inmigrantes indocumentados pueden legalizarse.
4. Hay que ver recursos legales para establecer la legalización de inmigrantes.
5. Hay que responder a las causas económicas, políticas y sociales de la inmigración.

Aunque sean generales estos principios, queden ser una guía para la policía de inmigración, propuesta por los obispos. Anticipamos los esfuerzos continuos de nuestra Recamara nacional a reformar la inmigración, para sacar de las sombras nuestros hermanos y hermanas inmigrantes y mejoras la seguridad de nuestra nación.
