REST IN THE LORD

For several weeks we have listened to readings that have recounted just how arduous the work of prophets and disciples can be. In today's Gospel, the Lord Jesus listens to the reports of those he had sent out "two by two" to minister to the people. After the apostles reported what they had done, Jesus, recognizing their fatigue, says, "Come away by yourselves to a deserted place and rest awhile" (Mark 6:31). Perhaps this is what the Lord is telling his disciples in the year 2009 as well. We need to pause on our journey of discipleship and simply rest in the Lord. Sunday Mass provides many opportunities for quiet times, particularly during the periods of silence following the readings. Why not take the time today to allow the saving word of the Lord to penetrate your heart during those silent times? Ask the Lord to renew you in body, mind, and spirit for the arduous work of discipleship.

Program in Spiritual Direction: Please support in prayer Berny Klapuch, Jo Ann Garza, and Deacon Terry Brennan, who will soon begin a three-year program in Spiritual Direction, to be given at "St. Peter Upon the Water" Center for Spiritual Direction and Formation in Ingram, Texas. This program is designed to equip Berny, JoAnn and Terry to be Spiritual Directors. We are sure to hear from them about all they are learning! St. Peter Upon the Water was founded by Fr. Mike Boulette, who was once stationed in our Catholic Community.

Lay Ministry Institute: We are looking for people interested in deepening their skills in ministry, and knowledge of faith. LMI is a two-year program of theology and spirituality available through Oblate School of Theology, consisting of weekly classes during the school year, along with retreats and other projects. It is designed for people who may have little background in religious studies, but are eager to learn and to become better ministers. Sam and Janie Melchor have just completed LMI, and Carney Zambrano will enter his final year of the program this year. Others who have completed LMI are John and Berny Klapuch. This weekend, please welcome Fr. Jaime Diaz, OP. As part of the Archdiocesan Missionary Cooperative Plan, Fr. Diaz will speak about the mission work of his congregation, and solicit the support of all in this effort.

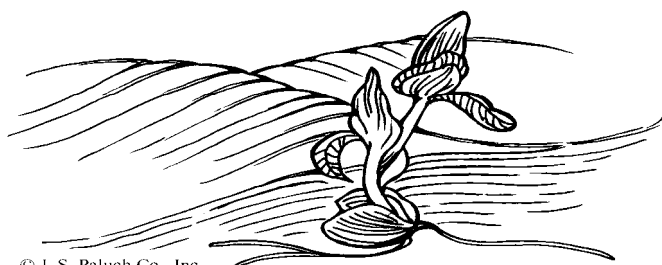
