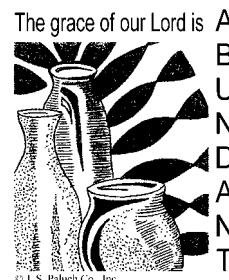
**Jamaica – junta final este jueves a las 6 pm;** se necesitan voluntarios para ayudar en la preparación, jueves y viernes en la tarde.

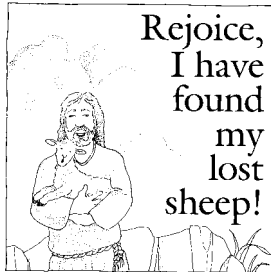
